Ms. Lacy's 1st Grade Newsletter

Curriculum Notes

Math

Students will use their knowledge of tens and ones to compare the value of two digit numbers (21 is more than 11 because it has more tens!). Students will also learn to measure objects with nonstandard forms of measurement (paperclips, erasers, etc.) and order them from longest to shortest, tallest to shortest, etc. Later, we will learn to determine the unknown number in addition or subtraction equations, using three whole numbers.

Social Studies

We will be learning about various customs, holidays and traditions around the world. Students will be able to compare and contrast various countries when we "travel the world" to understand and study how they celebrate!

Reading/Literacy

During Letterland (phonics), we will be completing Unit 11 "Consonant Blends with S" (sk, sl, sm, sn, st, sp and sw), Unit 12 "Consonant Blends with L" (bl, cl, fl, gl and pl) and later Unit 13 "Consonant Blends with R" (br, cr, dr, fr, gr, pr and tr).

Reading/Literacy (cont.)

We will continue to practice determining the difference between fiction and nonfiction books. We will also learn about text features in nonfiction books and use text features to identify information! Later, students will use text evidence to ask and answer questions about both fiction and nonfiction texts.

Writing

We will be writing all about "how-to do" writing to create an informational piece of writing, using sequencing, action verbs and illustrations for the reader to visualize the steps.
