Curriculum Notes

Math

Students will continue to review strategies for solving addition and subtraction word problems with fluency. Students will begin to learn about the value of coins/money! Students will be completing their "End of Year" Summative Assessments Work Packet, which reviews all standards learned throughout the year, as well as completing a "Number Knowledge Test" which measures their growth in math from beginning of year, to end of year.

Social Studies

Students will reflect on the social and emotional skills learned in First grade and discuss how they may use these skills moving forward in 2nd grade!

Readina

For Letterland (phonics), we will be completing Unit 30 to end our year! Unit 30 features other "OR" sounds and word patterns, such as "oor" (door, floor, etc.), "or_e" (chore, more, before, etc.) and "our" (four, pour, your, etc.)

Reading (cont.)

Students have reviewed identifying texts that tell stories (fiction), versus texts that give information (nonfiction). Moving forward, we will review the purpose of text features in nonfiction texts and use photographs/illustrations in texts to describe key details.

Writing

We have reviewed all different styles of writing: opinion, narrative, informational/explanatory. To end our year, we will become author's to write and illustrate a "School Memories" book! This book will include narratives of their favorite memories in First Grade.
