Curriculum Notes

Math

Students will continue to practice identifying place value within two-digit numbers (tens place and ones place), explain the reasoning used to mentally find ten more or ten less than a two-digit number, as well as use tens sticks and ones models to solve addition and subtraction word problems using two-digit and one digit numbers. Later, students will begin to further explore, distinguish and compose 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

Students will recognize the features and patterns of the Earth/Moon/Sun systems as observed from Earth, including differences in the day/night sky and changes in the moon's appearance from day to day.

Reading

During phonics, students will be learning long vowel sounds (a_e, i_e, o_e) as well as "ce" and "ge" word patterns.. Students will be learning how to identify the author's purpose in nonfiction text, and will identify similarities and differences between (cont.)
